Established by HRH The Prince of Wales in 2004, the Project is developing practical tools to enable environmental and social performance to be better integrated into organisations' core strategy and financial performance. Currently, the Project is piloting the "Connected Reporting Framework" and the A4S Decision-Making tool with key public, private and third sector partners.

Accountants have a key role to play in helping organisations effectively measure and account for their environmental and social performance. The CICA has been researching, contributing to guidance (in Canada and internationally) and recognizing good external reporting in these areas since 1991. The CICA is therefore delighted to be at the cutting edge of developments in this area through its work with the A4S Project.
